-Your pet will be undergoing general anesthesia plus a surgical procedure today. In order to recognize any underlying abnormalities your pet may have, we recommend having a pre-surgical blood profile run on your animal. It also assists us in choosing the safest anesthetic for you pet and aids in minimizing anesthetic risk. This consists of a CBC, which will check blood cells, and an ALT, ALKP, CREA, GLU, TP, and BUN, which will check blood glucose, kidney and liver enzymes. **This is bloodwork is required for pets older than 3 years of age.**

These blood tests will help us to assess the health status of your pet more completely and determine if there are any additional precautions we need to take before surgery. **We require a complete blood profile for geriatric animals (animals older than 7 years).**

There is an additional charge for these blood tests. We hope you understand the need for these important tests.

-We strongly recommend an IV catheter during anesthesia as this will help us maintain intravenous access in the event of an adverse reaction under anesthesia. This can help save precious seconds needed during an emergency situation to help us save your pet's life. It also allows us IV access to provide fluids, which help to maintain your pet's blood pressures and prevent dehydration, during the anesthetic procedure. The normal fee for an IV catheter placement and fluid administration has been discounted for this surgical procedure. When an IV catheter is placed, we also have a broader range of anesthetics we can use which lead to a safer/smooth recovery for your pet. **There is an additional charge for both IV catheter and fluids. This is required for pets over 7 years of age.**

I DO \_\_\_\_\_ DO NOT \_\_\_\_\_ wish to have an intravenous catheter placed and intravenous fluids given today.

-Antibiotics are used to help treat/prevent infections in pets as they are exposed to more external potential pathogens than humans due to contact. Antibiotics are used in pets post surgically to help PREVENT infections. **There is an additional fee for post surgical Antibiotics.**

I DO \_\_\_\_\_ DO NOT \_\_\_\_\_ wish to receive antibiotics for my pet today.

-Laser therapy can be used post- operatively to help with pain and aid in quicker healing. It has no side effects and is non invasive. It essentially helps stimulate good blood flow and reduce inflammation to affected areas-therby controlling pain. This is in addition to pain medication and not a substitution for pain medication.
